

INFORMATION BULLETIN**Written examination for recruitment to the post of Junior Management Grade of
Mizoram Cooperative Apex Bank Limited****General Information for the candidates :**

- (1) **The question paper for written examination will be in English only. The duration of the examination will be 90 (ninety) minutes.**
- (2) The question paper will contain 100 objective type questions with multiple choice options covering the areas of (i) English Language (ii) Arithmetical/Numerical Ability (iii) Reasoning and (iv) General Knowledge and Current affairs. There is no negative marking for wrong answers.
- (3) Mobile Phones / calculators / calculator watches or any such devices are not allowed in the examination hall. MCAB will not take any responsibility for the safe custody of the above items.
- (4) You should bring along with you, two HB pencils, a pencil sharpener, a ball pen and a good quality eraser.
- (5) The minimum qualifying mark and the number of candidates to be called for interview will be decided by the MCAB on the basis of performance in the written test and as per prevailing guidelines in this regard. However, the MCAB reserves its rights to reduce or enhance the qualifying marks depending on the performance of the candidates in the examination.
- (6) You may attend the examination in any order you like. However, in your own interest you are advised not to spend too much time on any one question. The merit list will be prepared on the basis of total marks obtained.
- (7) While answering questions you should read all the alternatives given before deciding the correct/most appropriate answer.
- (8) If for any question the candidate gives more than one answer it would be treated as wrong even if one of the given answers happens to be right. You should, therefore, be careful in marking your answers.
- (9) You must write your Roll Number, your Name and the name of the centre of examination and the date of examination in the space provided in the Answer Sheet.
- (10) No rough work is to be done in the Answer Sheet. However, you can do rough work on the question/examination booklet itself.
- (11) You must submit your question booklet and the answer sheet to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall. If you do not return the question booklet/and or answer sheet or is found to take or pass on the question booklet/and or answer sheet inside the examination hall, you will be disqualified and MCAB may take further action as per examination rules.

How to answer the questions :

Each question will be followed by four alternative answers which are numbered as a, b, c, and d. You should select and show only one answer to each question considered by you as the most appropriate or the correct answer. Then, by using HB pencil (ordinarily used pencil) blacken the oval bearing the correct answer number against the serial number of the question. No mark will be given if more than one answer is marked for one question. Please note that the oval should be dark

enough and should be filled in completely. For example, if the answer to Question Number 1 is 'b', it should be shown as follows :

1. a b c d

If you indicate your answers in any other way such as putting a tick-mark, cross-mark or a dot in the ovals, your answer sheet will not be evaluated. If you omit a question, which you find difficult, be sure that you mark the next answer against the correct serial number of the question.

How to change your answer :

If you wish to change your answer, erase completely the already darkened oval by using good quality eraser and then blacken the new oval bearing your revised answer number. While changing the answer, erasing the earlier answer completely is extremely essential. If it is not erased completely, smudges will be left on the erased oval and the question will be read as having two answers and will be ignored for giving any mark.
